

Our History

The Circle City Derby Girls are an all-female flat-track roller derby league based in Indianapolis. The league was founded in 2008 by a handful of dedicated skaters who began practicing at a former ice rink in Irvington. It has since grown to a league of more than 60 active skaters and dedicated volunteers.

In the Spring of 2009, we began traveling across the Midwest to compete with other roller derby teams under the name "Circle City Socialites." As our fan base blossomed at home, we soon outgrew our home venue at Ellenberger Park. For our second season, we moved to a larger venue - The Forum at Fishers. In our eighth season, Circle City Derby Girls moved to Perry park on the Southside!

In 2010, due to our rapid growth and addition of a second team, our league became known as the Circle City Derby Girls. Our A-team continues to play as the Circle City Socialites, and has been joined by a B-team, the Party Crashers.
